Sheriff's Deputies Finish Search for Body

Johnson County, Kan. – Johnson County Sheriff's Detectives and Crime Lab personnel finished searching the property at 16400 Mission Road late Tuesday evening August 31, 2010, ending with no evidence of a body.

The investigation and search began after the Sheriff's Office received a tip of a possible dead body at this location. The tip had specific information on location and condition of the building and area deputies searched but was not specific to the identity of a particular person.

During the week long search, the Sheriff's Office received cooperation and assistance from many partners, both public and private. These include Johnson County Infrastructure and Transportation, Johnson County Fire District #2, Leawood Fire Department, Johnson County Consolidated Fire District #2, Olathe Fire Department, Med-Act, the Kansas Search and Rescue K9 cadaver dogs and handlers, Johnson County Environmental, EPA, Union Pacific Railroad, Heavy Equipment Association and Hazardous Waste Company.
